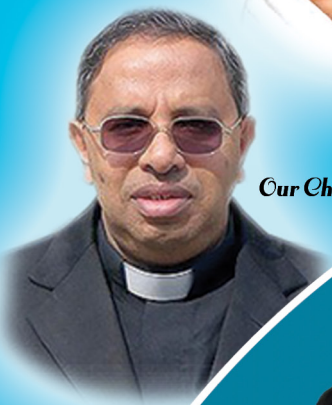

# Peace & Conflict Transformation Studies (PCTS)

We are the first institute in the country to introduce Peace and Conflict Transformation Studies as specialization under MSW course. It prepares community members and students to relate through interdisciplinary approaches to prevent conflict in the communities and organizations and help them to resolve issues.

## Youth Development (YD)

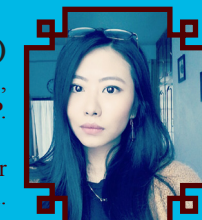
