12. Academic Support

In order to help students to plan their course of studies and advise them on academic programs and personality development, the institute will assign a Faculty supervisor/mentor for a group of students. Every mentor/ supervisor is required to visit periodically, supervise and monitor the fieldwork training. All reports are regularly corrected and weekly individual and group conferences are scheduled and held. The supervisors or mentors are expected to provide:

- a. Three-way matching of students-agency-fieldwork coordination in the department.
- b. Adequate supervision inputs to the agency supervisor.
- c. Counselling support, and assistance to the students for effective learning in the field. Extra efforts will be taken by the mentors to guide the students to develop the skills and acumen needed to be a professional in the field of social work.

13. Scholarships

Deserving students may apply for scholarships offered by the Diocese of Kohima. The institute also provides scholarships for meritorious and deserving students which will be awarded from time to time. The institution also provides the following scholarships:

1. Scholarship for the best students of the year.

Freeship Policy

North East Institute of Social Sciences and Research (NEISSR), a Social Work Institute is strongly committed to the goal of supporting less privileged students in Higher Education. The Institute believes that no student is to be denied the opportunity due to financial inadequacy. Keeping this in mind, the college makes available scholarships from both government and non-government bodies including individual donors and philanthropists. Scholarships are given to students based on need and merit. The Freeship policy is elaborated below:

- The institution provides Scholarships for meritorious and deserving students which will be awarded under the given criteria.
 1. Scholarship for the woman who is a widow and wants to study at NEISSR
 2. Scholarship for the differently abled and physically challenged
 3. Scholarship for students who are financially poor or have lost their parents

Institution Scholarship Amount: up to Rs. 10000/-

- The College shall make all efforts to create awareness among students about the various scholarships available as well as the application process and eligibility criteria.
- The college shall make all efforts to contact donors and request them to provide scholarships to needy and deserving students.
- For other scholarships, the eligibility criteria will be as laid down by the College management in consultation and approved by the College Governing Board.
- Scholarship will be directly credited to the bank accounts of students by the granting authority. If the scholarship is credited to the institution, the same is immediately disbursed to the students through cheque or is paid for admission/semester fee with receipt issued to the students as per the desire of the doner. The desire of the doner is always respected and fulfilled.

- All Scholarships are to be renewed respectively as per the guidelines.
- In case of any malpractice or violation of the laid down policies, rules and regulations, the Scholarship may be withdrawn at any given point.

2. Students pursuing any Professional Studies may apply for BAMS which is directly under the Diocese of Kohima.

Coverage:
