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Competition and its Criteria

- 1. Sketch competition
- a. There should be one participant from each college.
- b. The theme for the sketch competition will be based on the "Haves and Have-Nots". The theme is related to Sustainable Development Goal no 1 and 10.
- c. Participant should bring their own materials. The charts will be provided by the organizer.
- d. The judging criteria will be based on the creativity and originality, clarity of theme, quality of the art work, artistic skills demonstration.

2. Story telling

- a. There should be one participant from each college.
- b. The theme for the story telling is "A Tool for Promoting Peace and Literacy".
- c. The time limit for the story telling will be
- maximum 5 minutes. d. Judging criteria will be based on delivery,
- expression, body language and figure of speech. e. Participants shall not use any materials while
- presenting stories.

3. Motivational talk

- a. There should be one participant from each college.
- b. The topic for the motivational talk will be "Channelizing Youth Power for Society".
- c. The time limit for the talk will be maximum 5 minutes. Judging criteria will be based on content, delivery and language.

- d. Participants can use ppt (No other materials will be allowed).
- 4. Cosplay
- Free Registration. There shall be no limit in terms of participants.
- b. Props and readymade costume are allowed.

Information

- Each college is requested to confirm the number of participants before 30th April 2023.
- 2. There should be one participant from each institute in each competition.
- There will be registration fee of Rs. 100 per head.
 The sketch competition and paper presentation
- will go simultaneously.
- 5. Attendance is compulsory for NEISSR students. Absentees will be imposed with a fine of Rs. 300 each day.
