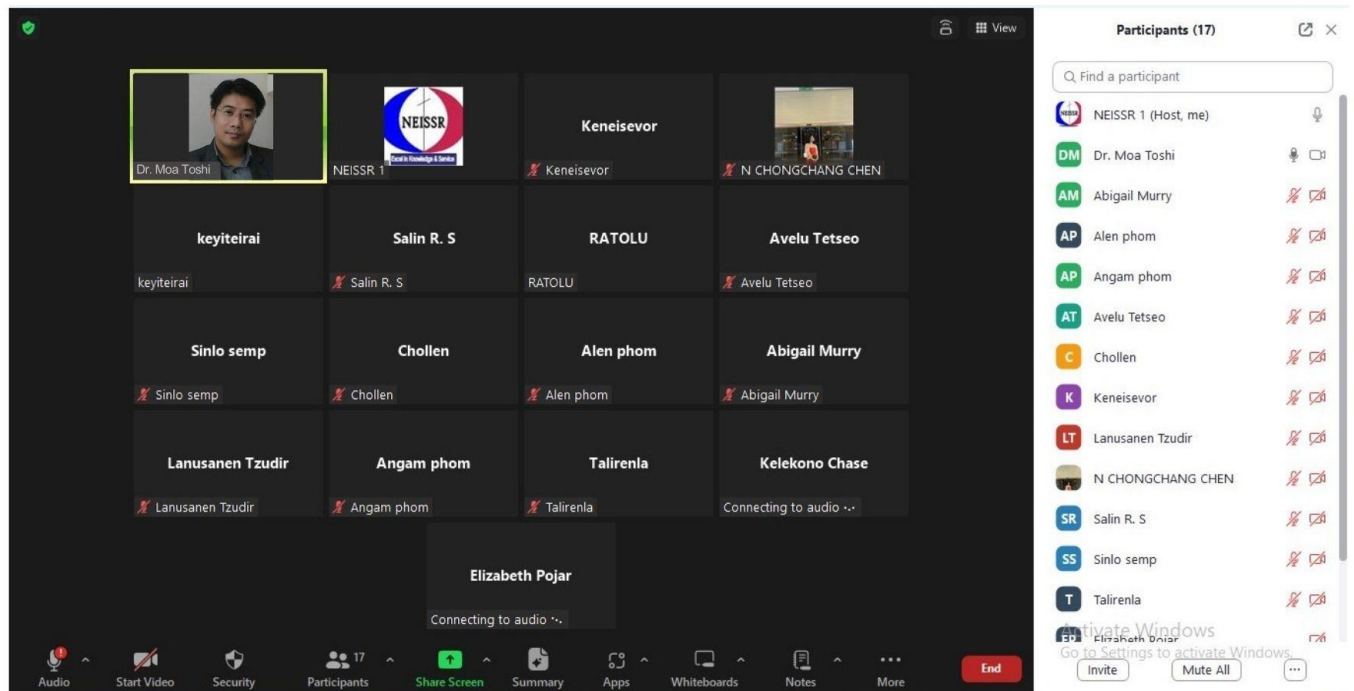
Online Report

North East Institute of Social Science and Research organized an online Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) program on April 26, 2020, to commemorate World Intellectual Property Day. The theme for the event was '**Innovation for a Green Future,**' aligning with the 2020 World Intellectual Property Day campaign. Dr.Moatoshi Ao, Assistant Professor in the Faculty of Law at the University of Delhi, served as the resource person, and the online session was moderated by Elizabeth Pojar, 4th Semester MSW, NEISSR.

Dr.Ao emphasized that the campaign aimed to highlight the crucial role of innovation and the corresponding rights in shaping a low-carbon future. Recognizing the increasing global awareness of the environmental challenges, he underlined the urgent need for collective action to address climate change. Dr.Ao expressed concern about the escalating frequency and intensity of extreme climate-related events, such as storms, floods, droughts, and wildfires.

Further, he stated that as we entered into a new decade, the impact of climate change became more evident worldwide. Dr.Ao urged the students to be environmentally conscious and responsible global citizens. He emphasized that, despite the daunting challenge of tackling the global climate crisis, each individual plays a part in the common goal of building a green future.

The session concluded with an interactive question and answer session, allowing students to engage with Dr.Ao. Mr. SinloSemp, 2nd MSW, NEISSR, delivered the vote of thanks.
