# NORTH EAST INSTITUTE OF SOCIAL SCIENCES AND RESEARCH (NEISSR) ORGANISED A WEBINAR ON A THEME, 'SCOPE AND CHALLENGES OF SOCIAL WORK PRACTICE IN 21ST CENTURY'

NEISSR (2<sup>nd</sup> Semester Students) organised a webinar on 26<sup>th</sup> June 2021 on a theme –Scope 7 Challenges of Social Work Practice in 21<sup>st</sup> Century – with an aim to explore the avenues and opportunities as well as to understand the challenges of Social Work in 21<sup>st</sup> Century.

Miss Livino S Zhimo, MSW  $2^{ND}$  Sem, NEISSR, MC of the day, welcomed all the participants and introduced the dignitaries & resource persons.

Rev. Dr. Fr C.P Anto, Principal NEISSR, Founder and Director of Peace Channel welcomed all the esteemed resource persons - Dr. Shampa Nag, Co- founder and Steering Committee Member Global Civil Society Network for Malaria Elimination (CS4ME). Mr. Itulungbe Ndang, President Nagaland Professional Social Workers Association (NPSWA). Mr. Namghaklung Christopher, Programme Officer for North East West (NEW) of CBR Forum, Bangalore. Dr. Fr. CP Anto spoke about the need to contextualize the primary and secondary methods of social work. He added that if we come together, we can overcome this pandemic and one should be more optimistic, positive and hopeful and fight this new normal with new skills, knowledge, attitude and information.

Mr Stephen Gangmei (Assistant Professor NEISSR), the moderator shared the perspective of the webinar and invited the first resource person Mr. Itulungbe Ndang, President of NPSWA, to speak. Mr. Itulungbe emphasised on the principles and scope of Social Work and said that Social Work Organisations and NGOs will need to work on new projects to tackle post-covid challenges. He also spoke on the SDGs and Niti Aayog which is a public policy think tank of the Government of India, established with the aim to achieve sustainable development goals with cooperative federalism by fostering the involvement of State Governments of India in the economic policy-making process using a bottom-up approach.

The second speaker Dr. Shampa, Nag, Co-founder and Steering Committee Member, Global Civil Society for Malaria Elimination (CS4ME) highlighted that in order to be a Social Worker, one needs to be very passionate and be grounded. In times of this pandemic when social workers are not able reach out to community people effectively, we should look out for ways and means to reach out to them either through various virtual platforms or reach out to them physically with proper precautionary measures. Dr, Shampa Nag said that young students should focus on our own interest areas like public health or women and children etc, so that we will have passion and zeal to work for it. She also spoke about the concept of Community Champion and the importance of networking with like-minded groups, organisations and people.

The last speaker, Mr. Namghaklung Christopher, Regional Officer North East West (NEW) Region Programme In-charge C1-CBR Forum, highlighted about the approaches of CRR (Community Based Rehabilitation) to work for persons with disability. He said that CBR approach can be used in tackling various community related issues and problem and need not be restricted to working for persons with disability alone. He encouraged the students of NEISSR to engage with people and have passion to help the community saying, 'If there's a will, there's a way'.

Mr. Tokavi Pucho, MSW 2<sup>nd</sup> Sem, NEISSR proposed the vote of thanks and the webinar ended with National Anthem.
